

APPROVED EQUIVALENCY CREDITS

2011-12 School Term

To earn academic equivalency credits at Puget Sound Skills Center (PSSC), a student must be enrolled in a Career and Technical Education program for a minimum of two semesters. It is the student's responsibility to declare intent to earn equivalency credits when enrolling in a PSSC program. At the end of two semesters the student may receive credit for up to three .5 approved equivalency credits if all coursework is successfully completed.

Students who enroll for more than two semesters may earn equivalency credits not declared or earned during the previous year. The sending school counselor will determine how equivalency credit will meet graduation requirements.

Auto Body Technology: .5 English

Automotive Technology: .5 English, .5 Physical Science (after 2 years in program)

Construction Technology: .5 English, .5 Algebra 1, .5 Geometry **OR** 1.0 Integrated Algebra 1 or 2
(not to exceed 1.5 total credit)

Criminal Justice: .5 English, .5 PE

Culinary Arts: .5 English, .5 Fine Art (FWSD only, .5 Food Science prior approval only)

Dental Assisting: .5 English, .5 Health, and .5 Anatomy & Physiology Lab Science

Digipen Video Game Programming: .5 English, .5 Algebra 2, .5 Fine Arts

Digipen Animation Academy: .5 English, .5 **OR** 1.0 AP or Standard Fine Arts, .5 Geometry

Digital Media Arts: .5 English, .5 **OR** 1.0 AP or Standard Fine Arts

Engineering Design: .5 English, 1.0 Geometry, **OR** .5 or 1.0 AP or Standard Fine Arts
(not to exceed 1.5 total credit)

Fashion Design & Marketing: .5 English, .5 Fine Arts

Fire Services: .5 English, .5 PE, .5 Health

Environmental & Marine Science: .5 English, .5 **OR** 1.0 AP Environmental Science

Microsoft IT Academy (formerly Computer Network Systems): .5 English

Nursing Assistant Certified: .5 English, .5 Health (pending), .5 Science (pending)

Translation & Interpretation: .5 English

Welding: .5 English
