## Gang Activity/Association Discipline Policy

It is the policy of the Highline School District that students who participate in gang-related behavior or activities will be subject to firm disciplinary action and be reported to the appropriate law enforcement authorities.

The type of dress, apparel, activities, acts, behavior or manner of grooming displayed, reflected or participated in by students shall not:

- Lead school officials to reasonably believe that such behavior, apparel, activities, acts, or other attributes are gang-related and would disrupt or interfere with the school environment or activity and/or educational objectives;
- Present a physical safety hazard to self, students, staff and other employees;
- Create an atmosphere in which a student, staff or other person's well-being is hindered by undue pressure, behavior, intimidation, overt gesture or threat of violence; or
- Imply gang membership or affiliation by written communication, tattoos, drawing, and painting a design emblem upon any school or personal property or on one's person.

First Offense: Short term suspension (students will be required to read and sign the school board gang policy and related procedures).

Repeated Offenses: Long term suspension or expulsion.
